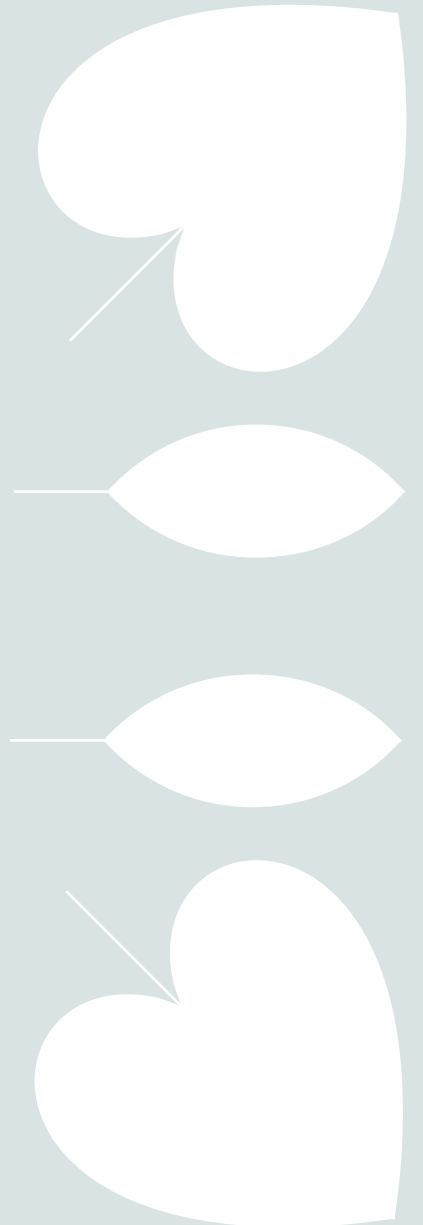

- ✓ Text with markup

- ✓ Geospatial data including raster and vector files
